



## ANNUAL ASBESTOS DECLARATION

Importer,

Since 31st December 2003 there has been Australian ban on the importation, manufacture and use of asbestos and products containing asbestos has been in place. Australian border force as part of its continuing risks assessment management have now advised it is importers responsibility to ensure they do their due diligence and make sure goods purchased for entry into Australian Home Consumption do not contain asbestos.

Mainfreight brokers are required on your behalf to answer community protection questions as to whether or not your goods container asbestos, so as a way to avoid minimal disruption to your business that you complete the below declaration.

This is your confirmation that you have completed your due diligence to ensure the goods imported by your company do not contain asbestos and have sufficient evidence if requested by Government Authorities you can produce to verify.

Evidence can be in the form of:

- Contractual obligation with their suppliers that specify nil asbestos content.
- Sampling and testing asbestos content prior to shipping the goods to Australia.
- Regular risk assessment and quality assurance processes
