LYTTELTON PORT OF CHRISTCHURCH – OPERATIONAL STATUS

Following this morning's 5.1 magnitude aftershock, operations were suspended, as a precaution. Lyttelton Port of Christchurch has sustained damage and we are continually assessing our operations on a case by case basis.

During the suspension of operations, our engineers reassessed the cranes and port infrastructure, and we can advise that the port has now recommenced R&D and vessel operations.
